

2026 INCENTIVES FOR EMPLOYERS

£1,000 Young Apprentice Incentive

All businesses can receive £1,000 for recruiting an apprentice aged 16-18, or aged 19-24 with an Education, health and Care (EHC) plan, or who is a care leaver.

£2,000 Foundation Apprenticeship Incentive

Businesses offering Foundation Apprenticeships to those aged 16-21 (or eligible 22-24 year olds) can receive up to £2,000, which support progression to a further Apprenticeship.

£3,000 Youth Jobs Grant

All businesses can receive £3,000 for recruiting an individual aged 18-24 who has been receiving Universal Credit and looking for work for six months or more.

National Insurance Contributions

Businesses do not pay NICs for Apprentices aged under 25 if the salary is below £50,270.

Funding for under 25's

Non-levy paying businesses do not pay the Apprenticeship Standard contribution for those aged under 25.

£2,000 for non-levy paying small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) in England when they take on new employees aged under 25.
