# Why Work as a... General Farm Worker

#### **ROLE OVERVIEW**

The occupation supports the operation of farm enterprises through maintaining a culture of health and safety, biosecurity, engaging with third parties, maintaining crop, animal handling and health, maintenance and cleanliness of machinery. The General Farm Worker will typically be required to drive farm vehicles and must hold the appropriate license. The individual will work alongside the supervisor, supporting daily operations for the farm enterprise.

   For example, tractor, quad bike, All Terrain Vehicle (ATV), Forklift
- The significance of producing crops to specifications and how this can be achieved
- The importance of reducing waste, waste legislation and how this can be implemented in the workplace
- The manual and electronic records that need to be completed and the importance of doing them
- Different customer requirements for product quality
